

# Where Did My Scoring Screen Go?

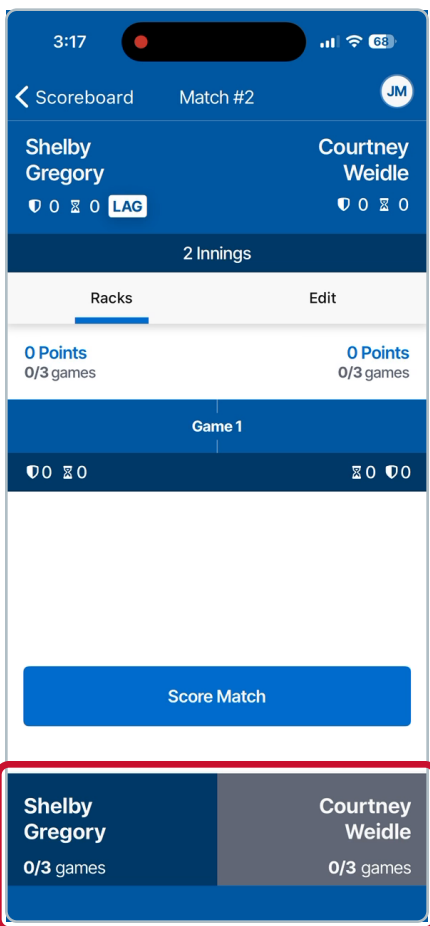
APA ScoreKeeper — quick fixes for the most common navigation mix-ups

## THE GOLDEN RULE — your match is never lost

If the scoring screen disappears, look at the **BOTTOM** of the screen for a dark bar showing the two players' names. Slide that bar **UP** with your finger and you're right back to scoring.

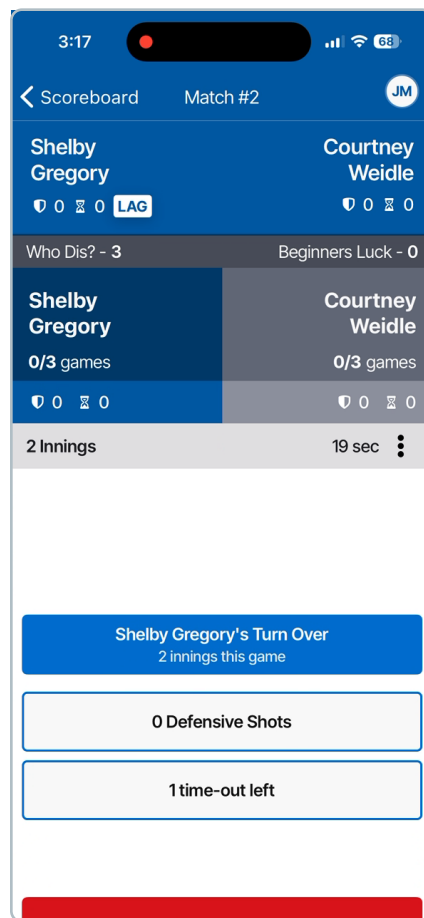
### 1 The scoring screen slid down to the bottom (the most common one)

This happens when you tap or swipe near the **TOP** of the screen. The scoring screen slides down into a “drawer” at the bottom, and you're left looking at the Scoreboard page with the Racks and Edit tabs. Nothing is wrong and no scores were erased — just slide it back up:



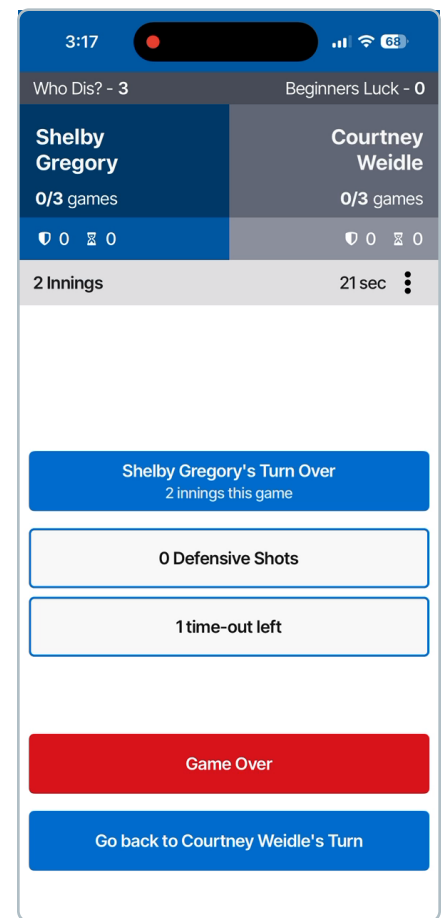
#### 1. See the Scoreboard page?

Your match is in the dark bar at the very bottom.



#### 2. Slide the bar UP

Touch the players' names bar and drag upward.



#### 3. You're back!

The scoring screen returns — keep scoring.

# More Quick Fixes

## 2 Tapped a button by accident?

### Tapped “Turn Over” too soon?

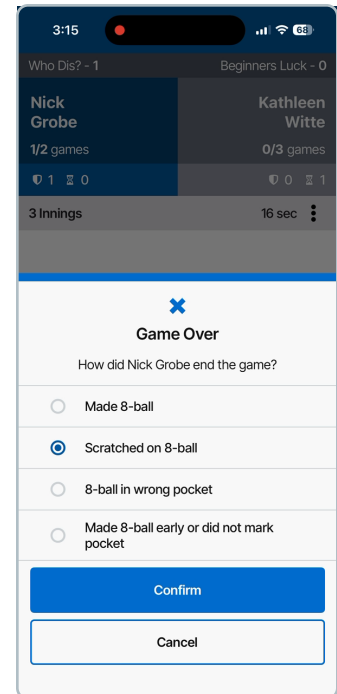
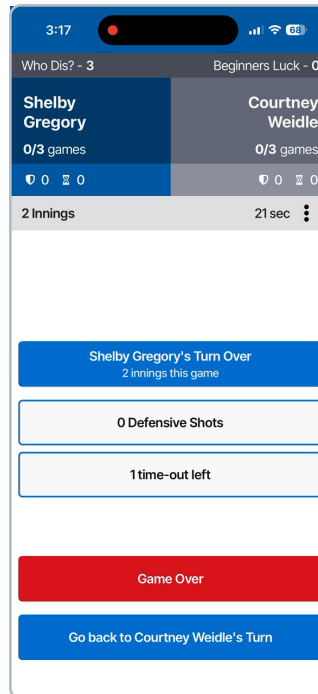
Tap the blue “Go back to ...'s Turn” button to return the turn to the right player.

### Tapped “Game Over” by mistake?

Don't panic — nothing is final yet. Just tap “Cancel” and you're back on the scoring screen.

### Ended up somewhere unfamiliar?

Look for a “<” back arrow at the top left, or the players' names bar at the bottom — one of them always leads back to your match.



“Go back to ... Turn” undoes a turn-over “Cancel” backs out of Game Over

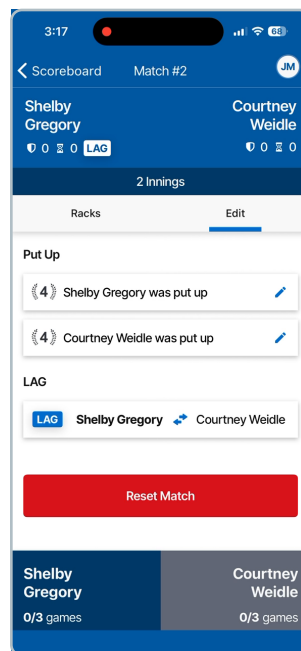
## 3 Entered something wrong?

Scores can be fixed during a live match. Open the Scoreboard page, choose the Edit tab, and correct what was put up. Watch the 1-minute video:

## 4 Need to start over?

If a match was set up wrong (wrong players, wrong lag winner), go to the Scoreboard page, tap the Edit tab, and use the red Reset Match button. Watch the video:
